ORDER

As Per Proceedings read as 1st Paper above, Environmental Clearance was issued to Sri. Nisar Rahim, for the Building Stone Quarry Project for an area of 0.9719 Ha., in Sy. No. 82/2 at Kondoor Village, Meenachil Taluk, Kottayam,

2) The Project Proponent, in his representation read as 2nd paper above requested to rectify the EC General Condition as Items No.18 mentioned in the proceedings as “a minimum buffer distance of 100m from the boundary of the quarry to the nearest dwelling unit or other structures, not being any facility for mining shall be provided”.

3) The matter was examined in detail and placed in the 119th SEIAA meeting held on 26th & 27th October 2022. The Authority observed that in the 87th SEIAA Meeting held on 14th January 2019 & 91st SEIAA Meeting held on 29th April 2019, it was stated that SEIAA Consistently - follows the KMMCR, 2015 and its amendments & as per that a minimum distance of 50m should be left from built up structures. Therefore the authority decided to issue an Erratum to the General Condition No. 18.

4) In the above circumstances, the General Condition No.18 of the EC issued as 1st paper above is modified and corrected as **“A minimum buffer distance of 50m from the boundary of the quarry to the nearest dwelling unit or other structures, not being any facility for mining shall be provided”**. The proponent shall follow the terms and conditions in the EC already issued.

5) The proceedings read as 1st paper above stands modified to the above extent only.
