## ORDER

Environment Clearance had been accorded for the building stone quarry project in Sy. Nos. 13/2, 13pt, 11/3-1, 11/3, 11/1, 11/1-1-1, 11/1-1-1, 11/1-1, 11/2, 12/2-11, 12/2, 12/1 and 11/1-1-1-2 in Edakunnam Village, Parathodu Panchayath, Kanjirapally Taluk, Kottayam district for an area of 4.1885 hectares vide paper read (1) above.

- 2. As per the Judgment in WP (C) 3814/2021 dated 15-02-2021, M/s Excel Granites requested for an extension of validity period on 08-02-2021. In the Judgment the Hon'ble Court ordered that the SEIAA shall consider the application and pass orders within 4 months from the date of receipt of all documents/details from the petitioner
- 3. On receipt of documents on 20-3-2021, the 121<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of April, entrusted a Sub-Committee for field inspection.
- 4. The 123<sup>rd</sup> SEAC meeting discussed and accepted the Field Inspection Report. The Committee decided to recommend the issuance of revalidated EC with a project life of ten years from the date of issuance of the first EC order subject to review every five years.
- 5. The 111<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup>& 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021, noticed the letter from MoEF & CC was received on 28-07-2021 regarding non-submission of required documents by the project proponent for the issuance of Certified Compliance Reports. Under the circumstance Authority decided to direct the Project Proponent to submit all the documents required by MoEF & CC and produce the Certified Compliance Report.
- 6. On receipt of the SATISFACTORY Certified Compliance Report from the MoEF & CC, the 113<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> April 2022, decided to revalidate EC for a period of 10 years from the date of issuance of the first EC order subject to review at every five years as per Terms and Conditions in the original EC in addition to the General Condition.
- 7. In this circumstance, the EC issued vide paper (1) is revalidated for a period of 10 years from the date of its issuance ie., from 5-12-2014, subject to the review at every five years as per Terms and Conditions in the original EC in addition to the

**General Conditions.** The Project Proponent shall ensure that no violation of EC conditions takes place during the revalidation period of EC.

8. The Half Yearly Compliance Report (HYCRs) with its contents, covering letter, compliance report and environmental monitoring data has to be uploaded in the PARIVESH portal and the website of the proponent. The HYCR mentioning the name of the project, EC No and date, period of submission are to be sent to the Regional Office of MoEF & CC by email ID <a href="mailto:rosz.bng-mefcc@gov.in">rosz.bng-mefcc@gov.in</a> & to SEIAA is <a href="mailto:seacseiaakerala@gmail.com">seacseiaakerala@gmail.com</a>.
