The following observations are made by the Committee after perusing the documents:

1. The fauna details are provided. But it seems to be incomplete.
2. More than half (52%) of the funds for CSR/CER will be spent on activities meant for individual beneficiaries. Development of community infrastructure has not received the required attention. The funds allocated for some of the interventions can be pooled together to make some more meaningful interventions to improve community infrastructure. It is suggested that the proponent may submit a revised document detailing the CSR/CER activities taking into account the Office Memorandum of MoEF on CER ( F.No.22-65/2017-1A.III dated 01.05.2018) and in consultation with the local self government. The year in which specific interventions will be implemented should be specified.
3. Promotion of education under CER needs to be certified by the concerned school. In the case of financial assistance to health centre, details such as the institution, purpose and when the intervention will be executed are to be specified.
4. The details of groundwater scenario submitted by the proponent only provides basics on groundwater. It does not provide any details of the scenario in the site/locality. There is no mention about depth variation. Such details should be furnished.
5. The proponent has submitted an affidavit stating that the CSR/CER activities will be undertaken in consultation with the Gram Panchayat.
6. Cluster certificate has to be furnished.

Hence the Committee decided to obtain the above details/documents from the proponent.
