ORDER

Smt. Usha.C, Soorya House, Kuttikattoor, Kozhikode-673008 has submitted an application vide reference 2nd read above for Extension of Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for mining of Laterite Stone from the land at Sy. No.26/1A, (26/11) of Mavoor Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode District from an area of 0.0971 ha.

- 2. The proposal was placed in the 114th meeting of SEAC held on 06th -08th October 2020. The Committee decided to recommend extension of EC for six months from the date of permit issued by the Mining & Geology Department.
- 3. The proposal was placed in 105th meeting of SEIAA held on 22nd, 23rd October 2020. Authority decided to extend the validity period of EC for a period of 1 year from the date of issuance of permit from the Department of Mining & Geology subject to terms and conditions in the original EC.
- 4. In the circumstances the Authority is pleased to extended the validity period of Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as per first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Smt. Usha.C,SooryaHouse,Kuttikkattoor,Kozhikode-673008 from the land at Sy.No.26/1A, (26/11) of Mavoor Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode District for a period of 1 year from the date of issuance of permit from the Department of Mining & Geology subject to terms and conditions in the original EC.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (iii) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (iv) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (v) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (vi) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (vii) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (viii) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (ix) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the

periphery of the excavation area.

- (x) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site shall be fixed.
- (xi) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.
- 13. Violation of any of the above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the Environmental Clearance, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance, if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Kozhikode by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
