MINUTES OF THE 112th MEETING OF SEAC KERALA HELD ON 12th- 14th August 2020 AT THE CONFERENCE HALL, STATE ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

The 112th meeting of the SEAC KERALA was held online during 12th- 14th August, 2020 observing all the lockdown protocols stipulated by the Government. The meeting started at 10.00 AM on 12th August, 2020 with Dr.C. Bhaskaran, Chairman, SEAC KERALA chairing. The Chairman welcomed the members to the meeting and informed that a number of applications for EC are pending since the SEAC meetings could not be held regularly due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Chairman also reminded the members that as part of the Field Inspection Reports, specific recommendations relating to the Project Life also have to be made as stipulated in the EIA Notification, 2006. He also informed that in view of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, the applications for EC in respect of the proposals for stone quarrying which do not meet the distance criteria stipulated by the Hon'ble NGT have also to be processed. The Committee then moved on to the deliberations on the agenda items.
