In view of the particulars given in the Para above, the project proposal interalia including Form-1(C)/ EIA & EMP Reports
were submitted to the Ministry for an appraisal by the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority, Kerala under
the provision of EIA notification 2006 and its subsequent amendments.

The above-mentioned proposal has been considered by State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its 169th meeting

held on 7th to 9th, August, 2024 and the State Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) in its 148th meeting held on 27th and 28th September 2024. The minutes of the meeting and all the Application and documents submitted [(viz. Form-1 Part A, Part B, Part C EIA, EMP)] are available on PARIVESH portal which can be accessed by scanning the QR Code above.

The SEAC in its 169th meeting, appraised the project proposal and noticed that several documents essential for reappraisal are not submitted or incomplete. As per the cluster certificate dated 11.01.2022, there is an abandoned quarry of area 9.2995 Ha within 500m radius of the proposed site which seems to be not closed. The Committee also observed other quarries within the cluster as per the KML file. Therefore, considering the cluster situation, the SEAC recommended the rejection of the proposal with a direction to submit application for ToR for EIA study.

The SEIAA, in its 148th meeting, has examined the proposal in accordance with the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006 & further amendments thereto. On accepting the recommendations of the State Expert Appraisal Committee, the Authority decided to reject the Environment Clearance for instant proposal of M/s Pallickaparambil Granite Works under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 and as amended thereof.

In the above circumstances, the application for Environmental Clearance submitted by Sri. O. Akhil, Proprietor, M/s Pallickaparambil Granite Works, Odamannil House, Mukkam P.O., Kozhikode for the Granite Building Stone Quarry Project for a mine lease area of 3.9271 ha, at Survey. No. 172/(Pt) pt in Kodyathoor Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode, Kerala is hereby **REJECTED**, for the reasons mentioned above.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
