#### ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.47/O.E/2019

Shri.A.K.AbdulAzeez,Sudhanath(H),Puthumanassery,Pavaratty

.P.O,Thrissur-680507 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for removal of ordinary earth from the land at Re.Sy.No.682/1,683/2,193/1 of Nelluvayi Village,KunnamkulamTaluk,Trissur District. The proposal is for mining of ordinary earth from an area of 3.4803 ha of land for removing a quantity of 22658.4 m<sup>3</sup>. The proposal was placed in the 99<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> June

2019. The Committee decided to invite the proponent for presentation and also directed to obtain the following documents:

- 1. Survey Plan approved by Village Officer
- 2. Photographs of the site.
- 3. Letter from proposed user

The proposal was placed in the 100<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC held on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> July 2019. The Committee decided to recommend for . EC subject to the specific condition that excavated earth should not exceed 6000 m3 and sworn affidavit will be submitted by the proponent stating that the excavated earth will not be used for filling up wetlands.

Later on, the proposal was placed in 96<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA held on 20<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Authority decided to issue EC for 6 months subject for a quantity of 6000 m<sup>3</sup> subject to specific conditions in addition to general conditions.

- 1. The excavated earth should not exceed 6000 m<sup>3</sup>.
- 2. A sworn affidavit will be submitted by the proponent stating that the excavated earth will not be used for filling up wetlands.
- 3. Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.
- 4. The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.

In the circumstances the authority is pleased to accord Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Shri.A.K.AbdulAzeez, Sudhanath(H), Puthumanassery,Pavaratty.P.O, Thrissur-680507 for 6 months for the removal of 6000m<sup>3</sup> of ordinary earth from the land in Re.Sy.No. 682/1, 683/2, 193/10f Nelluvayi Village, Kunnamkulam Taluk, Thrissur District subject to the strict compliance of the following general conditions and specific conditions.

## **Specific Condition**

- 1. The excavated earth should not exceed  $6000 \text{ m}^3$ .
- 2. A sworn affidavit will be submitted by the proponent stating that the excavated earth will not be used for filling up wetlands.
- 3. Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05,2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.
- 4. The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.

#### General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site (lithomark). The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation,
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site shall be fixed.
- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general and specific conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Thrissur by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
