HELD ON 24th & 25th FEBRUARY, 2020 AT THE CONFERENCE HALL,
STATE ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY,
THIRUVANANTHAPURAM**

**CONSIDERATION/RECONSIDERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL
CLEARANCE(Extension/Amendment/Corrigendum)**

1. SIA/KL/MIN/124909/2019 , 1549/EC4/2019/SEIAA

Mr. Aneesh Kumar S/o Kuttinarayanan Nair, Kommot Meethal, Manad Kakkancheri, Ulliyeri Kozhikode submitted to Member Secretary /Chairman State Environment Impact Assessment Authority Seeking Environmental Clearance for Laterite Building Stone Quarry over an extent of 0.9989 Ha under B2 category. Completed Approved Mining Plan, Required Document were submitted along with this .As directed by the Hon. High Court the 108th SEAC Committee heard the proponent. The Committee decided to recommend for issuance of EC for 6 months validity as per the mining plan. . The file was placed in the 103rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.

2. SIA/KL/MIN/128372/2019 , 1551/EC4/2019/SEIAA

Mr. Muhammed Unni Mammu ,Mundayil House, Ealamkulam, cherukara, Malappuram submitted to Member Secretary /Chairman State Environment Impact Assessment Authority Seeking extension of Environmental Clearance for Laterite Building Stone Quarry over an extent of 0.1426 hectares under B2 category.

The proponent submitted letter stating delay of implementation due to heavy rains. He has further requested extension for one year. The 108th SEAC Committee recommended for Extension of EC for a period of 6 months. . The file was placed in the 103rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.

1. SIA/KL/MIN/46912/2019 , 1514/EC3/2019/SEIAA

Sri. Muhammed (Managing Director), Vettakode Granites Pvt Ltd submitted a request before Member Secretary, SEIAA seeking quarrying lease for operating Granite Building Stone over an extent of 3.3624Ha under B2 Category . Completed Form1, Questionnaire, Prefeasibility Report with Approved Mining Plan and other required Documents were submitted along with this. The SEAC 108th Committee decided to approve standard TOR. The file was placed in the 103 rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.

2. SIA/KL/MIN/44876/2019 , 1456/EC3/2019/SEIAA

Mr. Jamal Muhammed (Managing Partner), M/s Aranhikkal Granite Unit Pathappiriyam P.O Malappuram submitted a request before Member Secretary, SEIAA seeking Extension of Environmental Clearance for Granite (Building Stone) Quarry with lease of proposed quarry extent of 7.2505 Ha under B2 category. Completed Form1, Questionnaire, Prefeasibility Report with Approved Mining Plan and other required Documents were submitted along with this. SEAC in its 108 th meeting appraised the proposal and recommended for the requirement of standard TOR with special studies on hydrogeological aspects as the total area exceeds 5 Ha. The file was placed in the 103 rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.

3. SIA/KL/MIN/45008/2019 , 1484/EC3/2019/SEIAA

Mr.K.B.Abdul Rahiman (Managing Partner) ,M/s Madeena Granite, Muthukurussi, Elad(P.O), Cherukara (Via), Malappuram submitted a request before Member Secretary, SEIAA Kerala Seeking Extension of Environmental Clearance for Granite (Building Stone) Quarry with lease of proposed quarry extent of 7.6315 Ha under B2 category. Completed Form1, Questionnaire, Prefeasibility Report with Approved Mining Plan and required Documents & Annexure for the Proposed Granite (Building Stone) Quarry with lease at Survey No. 1/1(pt) along with this. SEAC in its 108 th meeting appraised the proposal ,Since the area exceeds 5 Ha Standard TOR with special studies on hydrogeological aspects is


recommended. The file was placed in the 103 rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.


4. SIA/KL/NCP/46727/2019 , 1555/EC1/2019/SEIAA

CEO Technopark Phase 3 ,M/s Technopark, Park Centre , Thiruvananthapuram, submitted a request before Member Secretary, SEIAA Kerala Seeking Expansion of Technopark Phase III .The proposal will transform the vacant plot to developed plot GoK had earmarked 36.43 ha of land for the development of entire Technopark Phase III. Technopark is already having the Environmental Clearance for the development of 3, 40,000 sq mt built up area. Out of this built up area Ganga – Jamuna building (IT buildings of Technopark) with built up area 93,171 sq mt had already developed. The rest of the built up area is being developed. The SEAC 108TH Committee found that the application for ToR is complete except application fee. While considering the application, along with standard ToR, SEAC specified the requirement of the following special conditions :

- i) Increase surface water quality monitoring stations proposed for EIA study to 5 from the proposed number of 3. The added monitoring station shall be located in the downstream portion of Thettiyyar.
- ii) Ensure that selection of technology for STP is done considering the location of site and crossing of Thettiyyar through the proposed plot, adequate for ensuring zero discharge or cent percent recycle / reuse of treated water in the Campus for gardening/ toilet flushing/ make up water in the A/c system/ local ground water recharging etc.

The file was placed in the 103 rd meeting of SEIAA and the same was approved.
