ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.16/2019

Shri. T.P. Seetharaman, Managing Director, Kalyan Silks Pvt. Ltd, Kalyan Building, Kuriyachira P.O, Thrissur – 680 006 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA as per the paper read as second above for removal of ordinary earth from the land at Sy. Nos. 19/10 B, 19/27, 19/29, 20/4B, 20/5B of Nellikkode Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode District, Kerala. The proposal is for

extraction of ordinary earth from an area of 0.5049 Ha and the quantity proposed to be removed is 19000 m³.

The proposal was placed in the 94th meeting of SEAC held on 12th & 13th March 2019 and decided to seek a sworn affidavit from the proponent indicating the storage and use of the removed ordinary earth. Accordingly the proponent furnished the sworn affidavit on 26.04.2019. Subsequently the proposal was placed in the 96th SEAC meeting held on 26th & 27th April 2019 and recommended for EC.

The proposal was finally placed in the 92nd meeting of SEIAA held on 02nd May 2019. Authority decided to issue EC subject to the general conditions in addition to the following specific conditions.

- 1) The proponent should use the removed earth only for the purpose of construction of NH sworn in the affidavit.*
- 2) The Corporate Environmental Responsibilities to be carried out for an amount worked out proportionate to the total cost of the project as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 in consultation with the District Collector.*
- 3) During excavation the Proponent should scrupulously follow Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.*
- 4) Construction activities to be carried out as per the rules and regulations of local administration with sufficient environmental safeguards.*
- 5) Provision shall be made for the housing of construction labour within the site with all necessary infrastructure and facilities such as fuel for cooking, mobile toilets, mobile STP, safe drinking water, medical health care, crèche etc. The housing may be in the form of temporary structures to be removed after the completion of the project (Circular No.J-11013/41/2006-IA.II(I) of GoI, MoEFdt.22.09.2008).*

Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, is hereby accorded to Shri. T.P. Seetharaman, Managing

Director, Kalyan Silks Pvt. Ltd, Kalyan Building, Kuriyachira P.O, Thrissur – 680 006
subject to the conditions suggested by SEIAA for the removal of ordinary earth from an
area of 0.5049 hectares of land in Sy. Nos. 19/10 B, 19/27, 19/29, 20/4B, 20/5B of
Nellikode Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode District, Kerala. The Environmental
Clearance is accorded subject to the following general conditions.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site (lithomark). The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site, shall be fixed.
- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 . Non-compliance if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Kozhikkode by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority.
