ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.42/L/2019

Shri Harish Kumar, S/o Gopalan, Kodavamparambil House, Nagalasseri, Koffmehira Palakkad-679535 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for mining of Laterite from the land at Re.Sy. No.641 of Perumpilavu Village, Kunnamkulam Taluk, Thrissur District. The proposal is for extraction of Laterite Stone from an area of 20 cent of land.

The proposal was placed in the 96th meeting of SEAC held on 26th & 27th April 2019. The Committee decided to obtain the following additional details from the proponent:

- 1. Depth of mining of laterite
- 2. Volume of laterite to be mined
- 3. Depth of water level in the nearby wells
- 4. Consent letters from the nearby land owners
- 5. Proposed reclamation / land restoration plan / details
- 6. Mining plan if the depth is more than 2 m
- 7. Photographs of the site.

The proponent has submitted the documents on.29.05,2019

The proposal was placed in the 100th meeting of SEAC held on 11th & 12th July 2019. The Committee decided to recommend for issuance of EC with the following specific conditions:

- 1. Mining depth is to be limited to 4 m
- 2. Quantity of material to be mined should be limited to 80.90 MT.

Later on, SEIAA considered the proposal in its 96th meeting held on 20th August 2019. The Authority decided to issue EC for a period of 1 year subject to the following specific conditions and general conditions.

- 1) Mining depth is to be limited to 4 m
- 2) Quantity of material to be mined should be limited to 8090 MT.
- 3) Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.
- 4) The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.

In the circumstances the Authority is pleased to accord Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Shri.Harishkumar, S/o Gopalan, Kodavamparambil(H), Nagalasserri, Kothachira, Palakkad-679535 for a period of Lyear in Re.Sy. No.641 of Perumpilavu Village,

Kunnamkulam Taluk, Thrissur District subject to the following Specific and general conditions.

Specific Conditions

1) Mining depth is to be limited to 4 m

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- 2) Quantity of material to be mined should be limited to 8090 MT.
- Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-1A-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.
- 1) The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The exervation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (iii) The hirrowed/exeavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (iv) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (v) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (vi) Sufeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (vii) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (viii) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (ix) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (x) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site shall be fixed.

(xi) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance, if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Thrissur by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
