- (i) The activity stall not involve blating.
- (ii) The maxistrum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2 m finite great ground level of the site, which should be punimently marked before initiating to work.
- (iii) Reneval of eath should be restricted to 2 m subcreto the ground water table at the it.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall mot the natural lainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for unful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate facing all around the borrowed/exavated pit shall be made to present any mishap.
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to borrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers / labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of above conditions.
