JUDGMENT

This Writ Petition is filed for renewing quarrying permit. Exts.P7, P9 and P10 are the permits.

- 2. Petitioner submitted Exts.P32, P32(a), P32(b) and P32(c), applications for renewal of quarrying permits before the Geologist. These applications were not considered for two reasons. The first reason is on account of the order passed by the National Green Tribunal in O.A.No.171 of 2013 and another one is that this property is covered by notification issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forests.
- 3. Petitioner submits that based on the notification, Government of Kerala constituted a Biodiversity Board and they have prepared a sketch and as per that, the property of the petitioner does not fall within the ambit of Ecologically Sensitive Area. According to the petitioner, there is no embargo in considering the applications for renewal in accordance with law.
- 4. This Court already held that the order passed by the National Green Tribunal in O.A.No.171 of 2013 is in respect of river sand mining and not in respect of the quarrying permit. In view of

the above, there can't be any objection on the basis of the order passed in O.A.No.171 of 2013. Petitioner's case is that this property will not fall under the Ecologically Sensitive Area. Petitioner relies on Ext.P36 sketch of the Biodiversity Board. Therefore an enquiry shall be conducted by the Geologist in consultation with any other authority regarding whether this property is fall within the ambit of Ecologically Sensitive Area. If the property will not fall in the Ecologically Sensitive Area, necessarily renewal shall be granted in accordance with law by satisfying with other conditions for quarrying permits and without insisting environmental clearance. Needful shall be done within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
