ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO. 07 /2019

Sri. G.Vijayakumar, President, Navayikulam Farmers Welfare Cooperative
Society Ltd. No.T.1731, Navayikulam P.O.-695603, has applied for Environmental
Clearance for the removal of ordinary earth from an area of 6.70 ares of land in
Sy.No.533/4 at Navayikkulam Village, Varkala Taluk, Thiruvananthapuram District ,
Kerala for the construction of office cum commercial building as per the paper 2nd
above. The ordinary earth to be excavated is 700.18 m³.

2. The proposal was placed in the 94th meeting of SEAC held on 12th & 13th March
2019. The Committee decided to recommend the proposal for issuance of EC subject to
the condition that the proponent shall file an affidavit to the effect that the excavated
earth will not be used for filling up wetlands.

3. The proposal was placed in the 90th meeting of SEIAA held on 29th March, 2019. Authority decided to issue EC on the basis of recommendation of SEAC subject to general conditions and the condition that the proponent shall file an affidavit to the effect that the excavated earth will not be used for filling up wetlands.

4. The proponent has filed an affidavit as per the paper read as 5th above. In this circumstance, under notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with in paper 1st above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, Environmental Clearance is hereby accorded to Sri. G.Vijayakumar, President, Navayikulam Farmers Welfare Cooperative Socceity Ltd. No.T.1731, Navayikulam P.O.-695603, for removal of 700.18 m³ of ordinary earth from an area of 6.70 ares of land in Sy.No.533/4 at Navayikkulam Village, Varkala Taluk, Thiruvananthapuram District, Kerala for the construction of office cum commercial building. The environmental clearance is subject to the strict compliance of the following general conditions.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site. The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m. from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site, shall be fixed.
- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Thiruvananthapuram by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
