ORDER

Mr. Shibu P. John, Pynadath House, Sanjoe Nagar, Karukutty P.O., Emaloulant F683576 Kerala has applied for Environmental Clearance on 16.03.2014 in simplified format for removal of 10000 m³ ordinary earth from 0.8094 hectare of land in Sy. No. 2057 at Kuttichira Village, Chalakudy Taluk, Thrissur District, Kerala, for levelling the land for planting rubber. The removed earth shall be utilized for construction of Kole bund of KLDC Ltd. Forest land is not involved in the project. It is interalia, noted that the project comes under Category B, Activity 1(a), (i) of Schedule of EIA Notification 2006.

The proposal has been appraised by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee Kerala constituted by the competent authority, as per prescribed procedure in the lights of provisions under the ElA Notification 2006 and subsequent amendments, in its 28th meeting held on 25th and 26th April 2014. SEAC Kerala considering the application, documents and clarifications provided by the proponent in person, recommended environmental clearance to the project.

The SEIAA, after due consideration of the relevant documents and additional clarifications submitted by the project proponent, and in view of the recommendations of SEAC, approved for issuance of Environmental Clearance for the project mentioned above at its 30th meeting held on 9th May 2014. Accordingly, the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) Kerala constituted by Govt. of India vide Notification No. S.O. 2484(E) dt. 3-11-2011 of Ministry of

Miroriment and Forests, Govt. of India, published as Gazette extraordinary No. 2074 on 3-11-2011 and urther amended by Govt. of India vide Notilie aroun No. S.O. 546(E) dt.25.02.2014 Of Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India, published as Gazette extraordinary No. 466 dated 25-O2-2014, hereby accord necessary Environmental Clearance to Mr. Shibu P. John, Pyriadath House. Sanjoe Nagar, Karukutty P.O., Ernakulam- 683576, Kerala for removal of 10000 m3 ordinary earth from :0.8094 hectare of land in Sy. No. 2057 at Kuttichira Villags, Chalakudy Taluk, Thrissur District, Kerala, as per powers vested with it under the provisions of Environment Impact Assessment Notification - 2006 and subsequent amendments and also under the provisions made in O.M. No. L-11011/47/2011-IA.II(M) dated 18th May 2012 of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, and further subject to strict compliance of the following specific and General conditions:

The activity shall not involve blasting.

- The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2 m from the general ground (i) level of the site, which should be prominently marked before initiating the work. (ii)
- Removal of earth should be restricted to 2 m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) : (v) specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishal
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth durir
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the wa bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- Workers / labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation. (ix)
- A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half (x)depth of proposed excavation.
- A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of
- (xii) The quantity of earth removed should not exceed 10000 m³ out of which only the portion of e left after levelling the plot shall be given for the construction of Kole bund of KLDC Ltd.
- (Xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of at guidelines.
