CIRCULAR

Sub: Environment Department – Mining/Extraction of ordinary sand (കരാണൽ) - Environmental Clearance made mandatory – instructions issued-reg.

Ref: 1) G.O.(MS)No.02/14/Envt. Dated 21.2.2014.

 Letter No.4798/EC3/2014/SEIAA dated 13.5.2015 from Member Secretary, State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Kerala.

As per the letter under reference, Member Secretary, State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) reported that river sand deposit from river banks and former river courses are being extracted in large scale as 'ordinary earth' without Environmental Clearance; as ordinary sand (കരക്കേട്ട്) is not included in the guidelines on mining of minor minerals contained in O.M.No.L11011/97/2011-IA(M) dated 24.06.2013 of Ministry of Environment & Forest. Therefore, the Member Secretary, State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) requested State Government to give instructions to all concerned not to permit mining of ordinary sand or to extract and wash sand without prior Environmental Clearance from SEIAA.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail. The mining/extraction of ordinary sand without prior Environmental Clearance is against the true spirit of Environment Impact Assessment notification 2006 and the Government Order referred above. Hence no Government authority will issue any permit to mine/extract and wash ordinary sand without prior Environmental Clearance from SEIAA.
