ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.38/L/2020

Sri.Abdul Rasheed.C,Cheruvilayil House,Perinthattiri P.O,Malappuram-676507 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for mining of

laterite stone from the land at Sy. No.50/2 of Kottilangadi Village,Perintalmanna Taluk,Malappuram District from an area of 0.1942 ha for Commercial purpose.

- 2. The proposal was placed in the 99th meeting of SEAC held on 26th & 27th June 2019. The Committee decided to invite the proponent for presentation and also directed to obtain the following documents:
 - 1. Letter of intent / Mining plan approved by District Geologist
 - 2. Survey Plan approved by Village Officer
 - 3. Consent from neighbours
 - 4. Photographs of the site.

The proponent was invited for presentation on 11.07.2019.

- 3. The proposal was placed in the 100th meeting of SEAC held on 11th & 12th July 2019. The proponent was absent. The proponent has submitted the documents except mining plan on 24.10.2019 and intimated that he could not attend the meeting, as he has not received the intimation letter.
- 4. The proposal was placed in the 105th meeting of SEAC held on 28th & 29th October 2019. The Committee decided to invite the proponent for presentation along with approved mining plan.
- 5. The proposal was placed in the 106th meeting of SEAC held on 28th,29th & 30th November 2019. The proponent was present. The Committee decided to direct the proponent to submit the Approved Mining Plan and other documents sought earlier.

The proponent has submitted the documents on 21.12.2019

- 6. The proposal was placed in the 108th meeting of SEAC held on 13th & 14th January 2020. The Committee decided to recommend issuance of EC subject to the following specific conditions:
 - 1. Depth of mining should be limited to less than 4 m
 - 2. Quantity to be mined should not exceed 35,500 metric tonnes

- 7. The proposal was placed in the 102nd meeting of SEIAA held on 10th & 11th February 2020. Authority decided to issue EC for one year for a quantity of 35500 MT subject to the following specific conditions in addition to general conditions.
 - 1. Depth of mining should be limited to less than 4 m
 - 2. Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibility for an amount to be fixed later shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment including waste management in the project district as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC as directed by Director, Directorate of Environment & Climate Change and supervised by District Collector.
 - 3. The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.
 - 4. As per the directions contained in the OM F.No.22-34/2018-IA.III dated 16th January 2020 issued by MoEF &CC, in obedience to the directions of the Honourable Supreme Court the Project Proponent shall, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to his mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora, fauna etc. The compliance of this direction shall be included in the half yearly compliance report which will be monitored by SEAC at regular intervals.
- 8. In the circumstances the Authority is pleased to accord Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as per first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Sri.Abdul Rasheed.C,Cheruvayil House,Perinthattiri P.O.Malappuram-676507 from the land at Sy.No.50/2 of Kottilangadi Village,Perintalmanna Taluk, Malappuram District for a period of One year for a quantity of 35500 MT subject to the specific conditions at para 7th above in addition to general conditions.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (iii) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (iv) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (v) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (vi) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (vii) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (viii) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (ix) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (x) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site shall be fixed.
- (xi) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.
- 7. Violation of any of the above specific and general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the Environmental Clearance, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-

compliance, if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Malappuram by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
