ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.41/O.E/2019

Shri.Suresh.V.M, A/58, 1st Main CIL Layout, Sanjay Nagar, Bangaloor North, Karnataka-560094 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for removal of ordinary earth from the land at Re.Sy. No.S-167R-3-10-656, S-168R-3-10656 of Kacheri Village, Kozhikode Taluk, Kozhikode District. The proposal is for mining of ordinary earth from an area of 0.2225 ha of land for removing in to be 8900 m³.

The proposal was placed in the 98th meeting of SEAC held on 03rd June 2019. The Committee decided to invite the proponent for presentation along with letter of intent and photographs of the site.

The proposal was placed in the 100th meeting of SEAC held on 11th & 12th July 2019. The Committee decided to recommend for issuance of EC for 8900 M³ of ordinary earth subject to the condition that set back as per building plan should not be more than the depth.

The proposal was then placed in 96th meeting of SEIAA held on 20th August 2019. Authority decided to issue EC for a period of 6 months subject to the following specific and general conditions.

- 1) *The set back as per building plan should not be more than the depth.*
- 2) *Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.*
- 3) *The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.*

In the circumstances the authority is pleased to accord Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. read as first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Shri.Suresh.V.M, A/58,1st Main CIL Layout,Sanjay Nagar, Bangaloor North,Karnataka-560094 for the removal of 8900m³ of ordinary earth from the land in Re.Sy. No. S-167 R-3-10-656, S-168 R-3-10-656 of Kacheri Village,Kozhikode Taluk,Kozhikode District for a period of 6 months subject to the following general conditions and Specific Conditions.

Specific Condition

- 1) *The set back as per building plan should not be more than the depth.*

- 2) *Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibilities (2% of total project cost) shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment in the project region as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01.05.2018 of MoEF & CC in consultation with the District Collector.*
- 3) *The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.*

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site (lithomark). The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work

site shall be fixed.

- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general and specific conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance, if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Kozhikode by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
