ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO. 06/2019

Sri.Babu John, Palathumpadu, Thittamel, Chengannur, Alapuzha – 689121, has applied for Environmental Clearance for the removal of ordinary earth from an area of 18.60 ares (0.186 ha) of land in Re - Sy.No.15-5 (BL- 10/ 7739) at Peringanadu Village, Adoor Taluk, Pathanamthitta District, Kerala, as per paper read as 1st paper above. *

The proposal was placed in the 92nd meeting of SEAC held on 22nd January, 2019. The Committee found certain defects that the latitude & longitude of the land from where earth is excavated are not mentioned and hence directed to get these details

from the proponent, and entrusted Smt. Beena Govindan and Shri.V.N.Jithendran, IAS (Rtd) for site visit. The subcommittee visited the site on 19.02.2019.

The proposal was placed again in the 94th meeting of SEAC held on 12th & 13th March 2019 with the details. The Committee accepted the report of the Sub Committee and decided to recommend for EC subject to the general conditions.

The proposal was finally placed in the 90th meeting of SEIAA held on 29th March 2019. Authority decided to issue EC on the basis of recommendation of SEAC subject to general conditions and the specific condition that mining should be carried out only as per the approved Mining Plan.

Environmental Clearance under notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with read as first paper above is hereby accorded to Sri.Babu John, Palathumpadu, Thittamel, Chengannur, Alapuzha – 689121 for the removal of ordinary earth as per the approved mining plan from an area of 18.60 ares (0.186 ha) of land in Re - Sy.No.15-5 (BL- 10/ 7739) at Peringanadu Village, Adoor Taluk, Pathanamthitta District, Kerala for the construction of building. The Environmental Clearance is subject to the condition that mining should be carried out only as per the approved Mining Plan following the general conditions.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site. The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.

- (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site, shall be fixed.
- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Pathanamthitta by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
