ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO.33/OE/2020

Sri, Manikandan P.V, Pottammal House, Muthoor, Muthoor, P.O, Malappuram -679578 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA for mining of Ordinary earth from the land at Re.Sy. No.1/2A1, 1/2A3 of Pattithara Village, Pattambi

Taluk, Palakkad District. The proposed quantity of the earth to be removed is $50000~\mathrm{m}^4$ from an area of 2.4027 ha of Ordinary earth for Commercial purpose.

2. The proposal was placed in the 96th meeting of SEAC held on 26th & 27th April 2019. The Committee decided to invite the proponent for presentation in the next meeting and to produce approved mining plan and photographs of the site.

The proponent has been invited for presentation on 21.05.2019

- 3. The proposal was placed in the 97th meeting of SEAC held on 21st & 22nd May 2019. The Committee decided that the proponent shall submit the following documents/ details
- 1. Letter of intent/mining plan
- 2. Consent letter from the company
- 3. Work order

The Committee entrusted Dr.P.S.Easa & Dr.A.V.Raghu for field inspection.

- 4. The proposal was placed in the 106th meeting of SEAC held on 28th, 29th & 30th November 2019. The Committee decided to direct the proponent to submit the approved mining plan and the proponent submitted the approved mining plan on 13.12.2019
- 5. The proposal was placed in the 108th meeting of SEAC held on 13th & 14th January 2020. The Committee decided to recommend issuance of EC as per the mining plan.
- 6. The proposal was placed in the 102nd meeting of SEIAA held on 10th & 11th February 2019. Authority decided to issue EC for 6 months for a quantity of 50000 m³ subject to the following specific conditions in addition to general conditions.

- 1. The removal of earth should be in two benches. The excavation cannot be permitted beyond a depth of 4 m from the present ground level.
- 2. A green belt must be developed along the boundary line connecting BP1 and BP4
- 3. Periodical monitoring of water table levels in the open wells in the houses located at the foot of the hillock should be carried out.
- 4. The excavated soil to the extent possible shall be used for the programmes covered under government sponsored schemes.
- 5. The excavated soil shall not be used for filling the paddy fields or wetlands.
- 6. Activities relating to Corporate Environmental Responsibility for an amount to be fixed later shall be carried out leading to protection and promotion of environment including waste management in the project district as per OM F.No.22-65/2017-IA-III dt.01:05.2018 of MoEF & CC as directed by Director, Directorate of Environment & Climate Change and supervised by District Collector.
- 7. The proponent shall carry out quarrying as per the approved Mining Plan and the proponent should strictly follow the Kerala Minor Mineral Concession Rules 2015 and amendments thereby.
- 8. As per the directions contained in the OM F.No.22-34/2018-IA.III dated 16th

 January 2020 issued by MoEF &CC, in obedience to the directions of the

 Honourable Supreme Court the Project Proponent shall, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to his mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora, fauna etc. The compliance of this direction shall be included in the half yearly compliance report which will be monitored by

SEAC at regular intervals.

7. In the circumstances the Authority is pleased to accord Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. as per first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, to Sri.Manikandan P.V,Pottamel House,Muthoor P.O,Muthoor,Malappuram -679578 from the land at Re.Sy.No.1/2A,1/2A3 of Pattithara Village,Pattambi Taluk, Palakkad District for a period of 6 months for a quantity of 50000m³ of Ordinary earth subject to the specific conditions at para 6th above in addition to general conditions.

General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (iii) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (iv) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
- (v) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
- (vi) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
- (vii) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.
- (viii) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (ix) A minimum that ance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (x) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site shall be fixed.
- (xi) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.
- 7. Violation of any of the above general and specific conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the Environmental Clearance, in addition to

legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance, if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Palakkad by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority.
