- The activity shall mot involve blasting. (Î)
- The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2 m from the (ii) general ground level of the site, which should be prominently marked before initiating the
- Removal of earth should be restricted to 2 m above to the ground water table at the site. (Hii) (av)
- The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful  $(\mathbf{v})$ purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- Appropriate fencing all around the borrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent (vi)
- Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated (vii) earth during transportation.
- Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to borrowing/excavation of earth.
- Workers / labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation. (ix)
- A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at (x)least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of (xi)
- The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of (mil)
