# ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE NO. 09/2019

Shri.Muhammed Ashraf.P.V., Pulivalathil Veedu, Elettil, Koduvally, Kozhikode – 673 572 has submitted an application for Environmental Clearance in SEIAA as per the paper read as second above for removal of ordinary earth from the land at Re.Sy. No.17/1 of Raroth Village, Thamarassery Taluk, Kozhikkode District. The proposal is for extraction of ordinary earth from an area of 29.226 area of land for building construction and the quantity proposed is 1500 m<sup>3</sup>.

The proposal was placed in the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC held on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> March 2019. The Committee, after detailed deliberations, recommended the proposal for issuance of EC subject to general conditions.

Later on, SEIAA considered the proposal in its 90<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019 and the Authority decided to issue EC subject to general conditions as recommended by SEAC.

Environmental Clearance under Notification S.O. No.1533 (E) dated 26.09.2006 read with O.M. read as first paper above of the Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India, is hereby accorded to Shri.Muhammed Ashraf.P.V., Pulivalathil Veedu, Elettil, Koduvally, Kozhikode – 673 572 for the removal of 1500 m<sup>3</sup> of ordinary earth from an area of 29.226 area of land in Re.Sy. No.17/1of Raroth Village, Thamarassery Taluk, Kozhikkode District. The Environmental Clearance is accorded subject to the following general conditions.

### General conditions

- (i) The activity shall not involve blasting.
- (ii) The maximum depth of removal of earth should not go beyond 2m from the general ground level of the site (lithomark). The level should be prominently marked before initiating the work.
- (iii) Removal of earth should be restricted to 2m above to the ground water table at the site.
- (iv) The excavation activity shall not alter the natural drainage pattern of the area.
- (v) The burrowed/excavated pit shall be restored by the project proponent for useful purpose(s) as specified in the application.
- (vi) Appropriate fencing all around the burrowed/excavated pit shall be made to prevent any mishap.
  - (vii) Measures shall be taken to prevent dust emission by covering of burrowed/excavated earth during transportation.
  - (viii) Safeguards shall be adopted against health risks on account of breeding of vectors in the water bodies created due to burrowing/excavation of earth.
  - (ix) Workers/labourers shall be provided with facilities for drinking water and sanitation.

- (x) A berm shall be left from the boundary of adjoining field having a width equal to at least half the depth of proposed excavation.
- (xi) A minimum distance of 15 m from any civil structure shall be kept from the periphery of the excavation area.
- (xii) The quantity of O.E being excavated from each site is to be deposited at each work site, shall be fixed.
- (xiii) The Environmental Clearance shall be liable to be cancelled in any case of violation of any of the above conditions.

Violation of any of above general conditions as applicable to the particular case will entail cancellation of the EC, in addition to legal action under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Non-compliance if any shall be reported to the District Collector, Kozhikkode by the State Environment Impact assessment Authority
