- 3. The report on the water management plan need clarification. It is doubtful whether the proposed STP can bring down the BOD level to the stipulated standards set for the purpose of domestic reuse. - 4. It is advisable to stipulate maximum harnessing of solar energy. Therefore, they may include the possibility of harnessing solar energy in the EMP.Also considerable reduction of energy use is possible through improved design of internal architectural design which is not adequately addressed.
- 5. Emergency Disaster Management Plan needs to be worked out considering the number of occupants and architectural characteristics of the building

- ii) In the approved mining plan and power point presentation it is stated that topsoil of 7986 MT and overburden 7260 MT will be stacked in the dumping yard. But in para 3 of explanation furnished by the proponent it is stated that entire area is exposed by rocks and there is no top soil and overburden. This is contradictory.
- 95th SEAC meeting held on 27 & 28 March 2019 directed to proponent to rework the bio diversity report. But he again submitted a report dated 17-02-2019.
- iv) In the approved mining plan (p.15) it is stated that excavated material will be transported to crusher within 300m on side of the mining pit which is not true.

The Committee decided to ask the proponent the reason/ clarification for the factual errors noted by the Sub Committee.
